ORDER OF PUBLIC REPRIMAND

On June 28, 2012, the Disciplinary Board of the Hawai'i Supreme Court ("Board") conducted a hearing regarding the matter of Office of Disciplinary Counsel vs. Michael G. M. Ostendorp, ODC No. 10-036-8870. The Board reviewed the Stipulation of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Proposed Discipline ("Stipulation") filed June 18, 2012. Upon the conclusion of the hearing, the Board accepted the parties' Stipulation. The Board informed the parties that it would impose upon Respondent a Public Reprimand and the payment of costs.

It appears that Respondent committed the following violations of the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct, specifically:

1. HRPC 1.15 (f) (1) by failing to promptly notify the Government of his receipt of funds in which the Government had an interest; and


2. HRPC 8.4 (a) by violating the above rule.

Therefore, it appearing that a Public Reprimand is warranted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent Michael G. M. Ostendorp is PUBLICALLY REPRIMANDED and shall pay all costs of the proceedings as approved upon timely submission of a bill of costs as prescribed by the RSCH 2.3, Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i.
