PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU-The Hawai'i Supreme Court has issued an Order suspending Honolulu attorney **RONALD D.S. LAU** from the practice of law for an indefinite period effective November 24, 2010.

Lau's suspension resulted from his failure to cooperate with the Office of Disciplinary Counsel's ongoing disciplinary investigation. The public is cautioned and advised that Lau will not be eligible to practice law until reinstated by order of the Supreme Court. Lau cannot accept any new retainers, clients, or legal matters. Lau must also return to his existing clients their papers, property, and unearned advance fee payments.

Lau was admitted to the Hawai'i bar on October 23, 1987, and is a graduate of the William S. Richardson School of Law.
