PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU—The Hawai'i Supreme Court has issued an Order suspending former attorney **SCOTT T. STRACK** from the practice of law for one year and one day, effective 30 days after the entry of the order on May 27, 2011.

Strack's suspension resulted from missing important deadlines due to a lack of diligence and failing to correct his lack of diligence in a responsible and timely manner. Both of these failure caused real harm to the interests of his client. The court also found Strack failed to communicate with his clients in a timely manner, misused and mismanaged client funds, failed to properly maintain his client trust account, improperly organized his practice as an LLC, and misrepresented the nature of his law office.

The public is cautioned and advised that Strack will not be eligible to practice law until reinstated by order of the Supreme Court. Strack cannot accept any new retainers, clients, or legal matters. Strack must also return to his existing clients their papers, property, and unearned advance fee payments.

Strack was admitted to the Hawai'i bar on October 15, 1982, and is a graduate of Willamette University College of Law.
