HONOLULU- Upon motion of the Disciplinary Board and Mr. Salling's failure to respond, the Supreme Court of Hawai'i has transferred Honolulu attorney **MICHAEL R. SALLING** to inactive status on April 4, 2012. Mr. Salling will remain on inactive status until further order of the court.
