NEWS RELEASE

On May 1, 2012, the Hawai'i Supreme Court issued an Order suspending attorney **WEVLEY WILLIAM SHEA** from the practice of law for a period of twenty five (25) months, effective 30 days from the date of the Order. The suspension is based upon an Order issued by the Supreme Court of Alaska on May 18, 2011, suspending Shea from the practice of law for a period of 25 months, with reinstatement to the Alaska Bar being contingent upon his compliance with Alaska Bar Rules and evidence from a psychologist or psychiatrist that he is mentally fit to return to the practice of law.

Shea's reinstatement to the Hawai'i Bar is contingent upon proof of his reinstatement to the Alaska Bar, in addition to the requirements set out in the Hawai'i Supreme Court Rules.

Shea, 68, was admitted to the Hawai'i Bar on April 24, 1981, and is a graduate of McGeorge School of Law.
