PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU--On October 2, 2012, the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i Publicly Censured Honolulu attorney **ROBERT D. KAWAMURA** for neglecting a client matter for nineteen months, to the potential injury of the client's claim, in violation of Rules 1.3 and 8.4(a) of the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct.

While a Public Censure does not prevent Mr. Kawamura from continuing to practice law, it may cause the sanction for any future violations to be more serious than would otherwise be the case.

Kawamura, 52, was admitted to the Hawai'i Bar on October 23, 1987, and is a graduate of the Whittier Law School.
