

PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU -- On October 5, 2012, the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i issued an order placing **ALLISON L. JACOBS** on interim suspension, effective immediately. The interim suspension is based upon the November 14, 2011 Order of the Connecticut Superior Court of the Judicial District of New Haven suspending Jacobs from the practice of law until further review, pursuant to Section 2-42 of the Connecticut Practice Book, for Jacob's failure to timely respond to disciplinary proceedings and for admitted misappropriation of client funds in violation of Rules 1.15, 8.1(2), 8.4(3), and 8.4(4) of the Connecticut Rules of Professional Conduct.

Based upon the ethical violations in Connecticut, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel petitioned the Hawai'i Supreme Court for similar discipline.

Jacobs, 61, was admitted to the Hawai'i Bar on October 15, 1982, and is a graduate of the UC Berkeley School of Law - Boalt Hall.
