PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU - On October 12, 2012, the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i issued an Order of Disbarment for attorney **JOAN PALMER DAVIS**. The disbarment is based upon the February 27, 2012 order of the Supreme Court of the State of Georgia disbaring Davis from the practice of law for neglecting client matters, failing to communicate with clients, improperly withdrawing from representation, making false statements of material fact in connection with a disciplinary proceeding, dishonesty and deceit in violation of Rules 1.3, 1.4, 1.16, 8.1, 8.4(a)(4) and 9.3 of the Georgia Rules of Professional Conduct.

Based upon the ethical violations in Georgia, the Office of Disciplinary Counsel petitioned the Hawai'i Supreme Court for similar discipline.

Davis, 58, was admitted to the Hawai'i Bar on May 9, 1986, and is a graduate of Duquesne University Law School.
