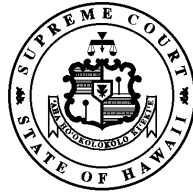

PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU--The Hawai'i Supreme Court suspended Honolulu attorney, **WING C. NG**, from the practice of law for one year and one day, effective April 1, 2013. His ethical misconduct included his bad faith filing of a Chapter 7 bankruptcy petition to delay litigation in California and with the intent to unduly burden and harass the opposing party in that litigation. He also filed a frivolous appeal from the dismissal of the Chapter 7 bankruptcy proceeding to the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. His conduct violated ethical duties of competency (HRPC 1.1), refraining from filing unmeritorious claims and contentions (HRPC 3.1), and failing to respect the rights of third persons (HRPC 4.4).

The public is cautioned and informed that Mr. Ng cannot accept any new retainers, clients, or legal matters until reinstated to practice law by order of the Hawai'i Supreme Court.

Mr. Ng was admitted to the Bar of the Supreme Court of Hawai'i on June 1, 2001.
