NEWS RELEASE

HONOLULU -- On November 27, 2013, the Hawai'i Supreme Court issued an Order Granting Petition to Resign in Lieu of Discipline for attorney **DOUGLAS D. OSTERLOH**, effective 30 days from the date of the Order. Resignation from the practice of law in lieu of discipline is a disbarment for all purposes under the Supreme Court Rules, including reinstatement. Mr. Osterloh will not be eligible to practice law in Hawai'i until reinstated by the Hawai'i Supreme Court, and he cannot accept any new clients or retainer fees.
