PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU—The Hawai'i Supreme Court suspended Honolulu attorney, **KHALED S. MUJTABAA**, from the practice of law for 180 days, effective July 24, 2014, based upon Mr. Mujtabaa's multiple ethical violations in two cases. Mr. Mujtabaa's ethical misconduct consisted of withdrawing client's funds before they were earned, misappropriation of client's funds, failing to promptly respond to client inquiries, and failing to diligently pursue the legal interests of his clients in violation of Rules 1.3, 1.5(b), 1.15(c), 1.15(d), 1.15(f)(3) and 3.2 of the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct.

The public is cautioned and informed that Mr. Mujtabaa cannot accept any new retainers, clients, or legal matters until reinstated to practice law by order of the Hawai'i Supreme Court.

Mr. Mujtabaa was admitted to the Bar of the Supreme Court of Hawai'i on May 12, 1989.
