

PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU—On August 13, 2014, the Hawai'i Supreme Court suspended attorney **CHRISTOPHER M. FUJIYAMA** from the practice of law for a period of two years, effective September 15, 2014. Fujiyama was suspended for the federal offense of intentionally and knowingly trafficking in counterfeit goods in 2012, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §2320(a)(1), which constituted violations of Rules 8.4(b) and 8.4(c) of the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct. In aggravation of his conduct, the Court found that Fujiyama acted with a dishonest or selfish motive and engaged in a pattern of misconduct which injured the corporate owners of the rightful trademarks. In mitigation, Fujiyama had no prior discipline, timely made restitution, cooperated with federal investigators and in disciplinary proceedings, received multiple attestations to his good character, and expressed genuine remorse.

Fujiyama, 44, was admitted to the Hawai'i Bar on October 27, 1995, and is a graduate of the William S. Richardson School of Law. [A copy of the Hawai'i Supreme Court's Order of Suspension is available upon request.]
