

PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU - On October 29, 2015, the Hawai'i Supreme Court issued an order allowing Diana R. Danmeyer to resign from practicing law in lieu of discipline, effective November 29, 2015. She is required to surrender her license to practice law in Hawai'i to the Supreme Court.

Ms. Danmeyer admitted that she renegotiated two contingency fee agreements without complying with HRPC 1.8(a), committed numerous trust account violations, formed a partnership with a California attorney in violation of HRPC 5.4(b), and shared legal fees with a California attorney in violation of HRPC 5.4(a).

The public is cautioned and advised that Ms. Danmeyer will not be eligible to practice law until reinstated by order of the Supreme Court. Ms. Danmeyer cannot accept any new retainers, clients, or legal matters, and must also return to any existing clients their papers, property, and unearned advance fee payments.

Ms. Danmeyer, 59, was admitted to the Hawai'i bar on June 29, 1998.
