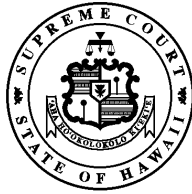

PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU—On April 8, 2016, the Hawai'i Supreme Court filed an Order of Reciprocal Suspension regarding attorney THOMAS ALFRED LANDRY suspending him from the practice of law in this jurisdiction for a period of nine months, effective May 9, 2016. Mr. Landry's reciprocal suspension is based upon his nine-month suspension issued by the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court for Suffolk County.

The Massachusetts Court found that Mr. Landry charged and collected an excessive fee, failed to explain the contingent fee agreement to the clients with sufficient clarity to enable them to make informed decision, and knowingly gave false answers to the clients' questions regarding the fee agreement.

Mr. Landry's reinstatement to practice in Hawai'i is contingent upon submission of proof to the Hawai'i Supreme Court of his successful reinstatement to practice in Massachusetts.

Mr. Landry, 61, was admitted to the Hawai'i Bar on October 30, 2003. [A copy of the Hawai'i Supreme Court's Amended Order of Suspension is available upon request.]
