

**PRESS RELEASE**

**HONOLULU, HAWAI'I** - On Wednesday, January 15, 2020, the Hawai'i Supreme Court suspended Maui attorney David A. Sereno from the practice of law in the State of Hawai'i. The suspension is effective immediately and is to continue until further order of the court. Mr. Sereno is suspended due to his failure to cooperate in two pending disciplinary matters, one of which precipitated the petition for suspension, and another matter that came to light while the non-cooperation petition was pending.

Upon entry of this suspension order, Mr. Sereno shall not accept any new retainer or engage as attorney for another in any new case or legal matter of any nature. Mr. Sereno is required to promptly notify all of his clients, and any attorneys for any adverse party in any pending litigation, of his suspension and consequent inability to act as an attorney. Mr. Sereno shall surrender to all clients all papers and property to which the clients are entitled and any advance payments of fees that have not been earned.

Mr. Sereno, age 58, was admitted to the Hawai'i bar in 1988, and is a graduate of the University of Hawai'i, William S. Richardson School of Law. If there are any questions, please contact me at (808) 469-4026.
