

PRESS RELEASE

HONOLULU, HAWAI'I - On March 22, 2022, the Hawai'i Supreme Court imposed a three-year suspension from the practice of law on Honolulu Attorney Noah D. Fiddler. The suspension is retroactive to July 16, 2021, with the balance of the period of suspension beyond March 22, 2022 stayed pending completion of a period of probation continuing until November 1, 2025.

Mr. Fiddler previously entered into a deferred acceptance of guilt to five felony counts of the willful failure to collect and pay over a tax, and twelve misdemeanor counts of willful failure to file a tax return. Proceedings for professional discipline on conviction of a crime were then commenced that resulted in an order of restraint effective July 16, 2021 that was deemed a suspension from the practice of law. Fiddler then entered into a stipulation with the Disciplinary Board of the Hawai'i Supreme Court to impose formal discipline of a 3-year suspension, stayed, with actual suspension retroactive to the date of the order of restraint, through the entry of the order of suspension. While on probation, Mr. Fiddler will be required to comply with various terms and conditions of probation and submit to monitoring by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel.
