

HONOLULU, HAWAI'I - On May 18, 2022, the Hawai'i Supreme Court transferred Honolulu attorney Preston A. Gima (Hawai'i bar number 2710) to inactive status due to incapacity pursuant to the Rules of the Supreme Court of Hawai'i, Rule 2.19(b) and (c), as he is suffering from an infirmity which prevents him from adequately defending himself in a pending disciplinary matter.
