
On May 15, 2024, the order to show cause was entered.



Based on a review of the record, we conclude that transfer to inactive status is warranted. Therefore,

It is hereby ordered:

A. ODC's motion is granted. Respondent A. EDWARD FYFFE, JR., also known as ALBERT EDWARD FYFFE is transferred to inactive status in this jurisdiction pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.19(a) effective with the filing of this order. Respondent shall remain on inactive status until further order of this court.

B. Pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.19(a), ODC shall serve a copy of this order on Respondent's guardian, and may serve the copy by e-mail if the guardian consents to service by e-mail.

C. ODC shall hold in abeyance any proceeding against Respondent to the extent required by RSCH Rule 2.19(h).

D. In accordance with RSCH Rule 2.19(d), the Disciplinary Board shall publish a notice of this transfer to inactive status.

E. The clerk of the court shall transmit a certified copy of this order to all judges of the State of Hawai'i.
