ORDER

Upon consideration of the Petition For, and Memorandum in Support of, Reciprocal Action (Petition), filed on April 28, 2025, by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel pursuant to Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawaii (RSCH) Rule 2.15; this court's May 20, 2025 Notice and Order; and Respondent Steven Hosoda Burke's June 26, 2025 Joinder to Petition for Reciprocal Action Pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.15,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. Respondent Burke is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Hawaii for six months and one day, effective



30 days after the date of this order, as provided by RSCH Rule 2.3(a)(2) and RSCH Rule 2.16(c).

2. Respondent Burke shall, within 10 days after the effective date of his suspension, file with this court an affidavit that he has fully complied with the duties of an attorney suspended pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.16(d).

3. Respondent Burke shall bear any costs associated with these reciprocal disciplinary proceedings, pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.3(c), upon approval of a timely-submitted verified bill of costs by the Office of Disciplinary Counsel.

4. Respondent Burke's reinstatement in the State of Hawai'i is conditioned upon (a) compliance with applicable provisions in RSCH Rule 2.17, (b) payment of costs of this proceeding, and (c) submission of proof of compliance with all conditions imposed by the Supreme Court of Nevada, and an order of reinstatement from the Supreme Court of Nevada.
