Upon review of Petitioner Office of Disciplinary
Counsel's (ODC) May 12, 2026 petition for the immediate
suspension of Respondent Roger Y. Dewa (Respondent) from the
practice of law pursuant to Rule 2.12A of the Rules of the
Supreme Court of the State of Hawaii (RSCH); Respondent's June
12, 2026 response; ODC's July 17, 2026 reply; and the record, it
appears that:

(1) ODC has a pending investigation against Respondent
in ODC Case No. 25-0112;



(2) Respondent has failed to provide complete financial, bookkeeping, and other documents that were subpoenaed by ODC as part of that investigation;

(3) Respondent has therefore failed to cooperate with ODC's lawful investigation, including failing to comply with a lawfully issued subpoena.

Therefore, it is hereby ordered as follows:

A. Respondent Roger Y. Dewa is suspended from the practice of law pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.12A, effective immediately and until further order of this court.

B. This order imposing suspension upon Respondent Dewa shall constitute a suspension for the purposes of RSCH Rule 2.16, although the suspension is immediate under RSCH Rule 2.12A. Respondent Roger Y. Dewa is granted twenty (20) days from the date of this order to comply with the duties imposed upon him by RSCH Rule 2.16 and to file with this court the affidavit required by RSCH Rule 2.16(d).

C. The Clerk shall distribute a copy of this order to all judges, pursuant to RSCH Rule 2.16(f). Distribution may be by electronic mail.
