ORDER OF PUBLIC REPRIMAND

On August 30, 2012, the Disciplinary Board of the Hawai'i Supreme Court ("Board") conducted a hearing regarding the matters of Office of Disciplinary Counsel vs Thomas P. Dunn, ODC No. 11-034-8958. The Board reviewed the Proposed Stipulation of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Discipline ("Stipulation") filed on July 11, 2012. Upon the conclusion of the hearing, the Board accepted the parties' Stipulation. The Board informed the parties that it would impose upon Respondent a Public Reprimand and the payment of costs.

It appears that Respondent committed the following violations of the Hawai'i Rules of Professional Conduct, specifically:

1. HRPC 8.4 (b) by having been convicted of five counts of violating Section 231-35 of the Hawai'i Revised Statutes; and
2. HRPC 8.4 (a) by violating the above rule.

Therefore, it appearing that a Public Reprimand is warranted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent Thomas P. Dunn is PUBLICALLY REPRIMANDED and shall pay all costs of the proceedings as approved upon timely submission of a bill of costs as prescribed by the RSCH 2.3, Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i.
