PUBLIC ORDER OF DISCIPLINE

This matter was considered by the DISCIPLINARY BOARD OF THE HAWAI'I SUPREME COURT ("Board") at its regularly scheduled meeting on January 26, 2012. The Board reviewed the parties' Stipulation of Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation for Discipline filed on November 7, 2011 (a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as **Exhibit A**), and also the information presented to the Board by Petitioner and Respondent.

Based on its review, the BOARD HEREBY CONCLUDES AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

- The parties' Stipulation of Facts, and Conclusions
 of Law, is accepted and adopted as the Board's Findings of Fact and
 Conclusions of Law.
- 2. The Board rejected the parties' recommendation for discipline and determined that a Public Reprimand is the

appropriate sanction for Respondent's misconduct. Neither party has rejected the Board's decision to impose a Public Reprimand.

- 3. A PUBLIC REPRIMAND is hereby imposed upon Respondent pursuant to RSCH 2.3(a)(4), RSCH 2.7(d), and DBR 27, Disciplinary Board Rules.
- 4. Respondent shall reimburse the Disciplinary Board for all costs relating to this proceeding pursuant to RSCH 2.3(c).

This Order shall constitute a permanent record of the imposition of such a Public Reprimand upon Respondent. Petitioner shall provide appropriate public notice of this Order.
