RULES OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF HAWAI'I (By: Recktenwald, C.J., Nakayama, McKenna, Wilson, and Eddins, JJ.)

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 2.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the State of Hawai'i is amended, effective July 1, 2022, as follows (deleted material is bracketed and stricken; new material is underscored):

## Rule 2. DISCIPLINARY RULES.

## 2.1. Jurisdiction.

Any attorney admitted, <u>specially admitted</u>, or <u>granted limited</u> <u>admission</u>, <u>under any provision of Rule 1.1</u>, <u>et seq</u>. of these Rules, to practice law in this state, <u>and</u> any attorney <u>licensed to practice law by the</u> <u>highest court of a state or territory of the United States or the District of</u> <u>Columbia</u>, <u>but not admitted in this state</u>, who practices law or renders or <u>offers to render any legal services in this</u> state [<del>specially admitted by a</del> <del>court of this state for a particular proceeding, and any attorney specially</del> <del>admitted appear in an arbitration proceeding under Rule 1.9A of these</del> <del>Rules</del>] is subject to the [<del>exclusive</del>] disciplinary jurisdiction of the supreme court and the Board hereinafter established. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to deny to any court such powers as are necessary for that court to maintain control over proceedings conducted before it, such as the power of contempt, nor to prohibit any bar association from censuring a member or suspending or expelling a member from membership in the association. Further, nothing herein contained shall be construed to deny to any arbitrator or arbitration panel such powers as the arbitrator or arbitration panel may have that are necessary to maintain control over a particular arbitration proceeding.
